

BPOMAS Management Committee (ManCo) Statement On Organizational Matters

OFFICIAL STATEMENT

Gaborone, 12 November 2025 – The Management Committee (ManCo) of the Botswana Public Officers Medical Aid Scheme (BPOMAS) wishes to inform its Members and Stakeholders that the ManCo has taken an administrative decision to place the Chief Executive Officer on garden leave pending the outcome of an internal process in line with Scheme policies.

This step has been taken to allow for a fair, transparent, and objective review of matters that have been brought to the attention of the Board.

The decision does not in any way presume wrongdoing and should be regarded purely as an administrative measure to protect the integrity of both the process and the institution.

During this period, interim leadership arrangements have been put in place to ensure the continued smooth operation of the Scheme and uninterrupted service delivery to members and stakeholders.

The ManCo reaffirms its commitment to good governance, accountability, and adherence to due process in the management of the Scheme's affairs. As this is an internal matter currently under review, BPOMAS will not be commenting further until the process has been concluded.

BPOMAS remains focused on fulfilling its mandate of providing quality, sustainable, and affordable healthcare coverage to its members.
